Call for papers

This year's focus

Music Research Today 2020 welcomes contributions from all music-related research within musicology, music education, artistic research in music, music theory, music therapy, music psychology and other disciplines. The theme this year is open.

Language

The main languages of the conference are Swedish and English. Presentations can also be made in Danish and Norwegian.

Membership in the *Swedish Society for Music Research*

All conference participants must be members of the *Swedish Society for Music Research*. For information on how to become a member see www.musikforskning.se.

Presentation form and length

Conference contributions can be presented in one of the following formats: paper, lecture-recital, and panel.

Paper: an oral presentation by one or more researchers. Time: 20 minutes plus 10 minutes for questions and comments. For students at an advanced level, 10 minutes plus 5 minutes for questions and comments.

Lecture-recital: a presentation form designed for researchers who want to integrate practical demonstrations or performance in their presentations. Time: 40 minutes plus 10 minutes for questions and comments.

Panel: a group of researchers present and discuss a shared project or research topic focusing on a shared subject. Time: 30 minutes plus 10 minutes for questions and comments.

Abstract

Send your abstract to: Musikforskningskonferens@mhm.lu.se no later than **February 7, 2020**.

Your abstract must contain:

- the title of your presentation
- a summary of the presentation of no more than 300 words (questions, theory and method, results and conclusions)
- information about the form of the presentation (paper, lecture-recital, panel, or poster)
- information about technical requirements (a projector and sound system are available in all rooms)
- name and (where applicable) institutional affiliation of all participants
- contact information for the presenter or group coordinator

Presentations will be chosen based on their scholarly / research quality and originality. Confirmation of acceptance will be communicated by February 25, 2020.

Other information

Conference fee and registration

The conference fee is 800 kr, membership dues are 250 kr payable to the Society. The conference fee includes coffee breaks, lunch on June 11th, as well as the conference dinner on the same day. The conference fee applies whether the participant attends one or more days.

Also: For doctoral students without doctoral positions, students, and retirees, the conference fee is 500 kr. Students at advanced levels that participate with a presentation of their own do not have to pay the conference fee.

Confirmed registrations and payment of the conference fee and the membership dues must be received no later than **May 15, 2020 to bankgiro 5227-4784**.
