Welcome to the annual conference of the Swedish Society for Music Research. The conference welcomes researchers, doctoral candidates, and other students within the field of music and will take place this year in Stockholm, 13-15/6.

This year's focus

The theme of *Music Research Today – 2023* is open and we welcome contributions from all kinds of research within musicology, music education, artistic research in music, music theory, music therapy, music psychology as well as music-related research in other disciplines.

Language

The main languages of the conference are Swedish and English. Presentations can also be made in Danish and Norwegian.

Membership in the *Swedish Society for Music Research*

The conference is organised by the *Swedish Society for Music Research* and all conference participants must be members. As a member of SSM you gain access to the conference as well as the *Swedish Journal of Music Research* (STM-SJM).

Presentation format and length

Conference contributions can be presented in one of the following formats: traditional paper, lecture-recital, panel, paired papers, video essay/audio paper, or poster.

- A. **Paper:** an oral presentation by one or more researchers. Time: 20 minutes + 10 minutes for questions and comments. Undergraduate and Master or Magister-level graduate students are also invited to present finished thesis projects (10 minutes + 5 minutes for questions and comments). Supervisors are kindly asked to advise students of this opportunity.
- B. **Lecture-recital:** an oral presentation that integrates a practical demonstration or live performance. The demonstration or performance must be an integral part of the presentation and not merely serve as an illustration. The lecture-recital format is open to researchers and students from all fields of music research. Time: 20–40 minutes + 10 minutes for questions and comments. The conference committee will allocate time depending on the scope of the overall conference programme.
- C. **Panel:** a group of at least three researchers who present and discuss a shared project or research topic. Time: 30 minutes + 10 minutes for questions and comments.
- D. **Paired papers:** two papers approaching the same problem or subject from different angles, followed by discussion. Time: 15 minutes per paper + 20 minutes for discussion. A separate abstract for each paper is required, as well as a short description of how they are related.
- E. **Video essay/audio paper:** A video or audio production that includes an academic argument or question that is expressed in words, images and/or sound. The recording should be 15–20 minutes in length and will be followed by a discussion of 10–15 minutes.

Abstract

Please submit your abstract to: mliconsult.magdalena@gmail.com no later than February 1, 2023.

The abstract must contain:

- The title of your presentation
- A concise summary of the presentation (maximum 300 words) including research question(s), theory, method, results, and conclusions. (Reference lists are not included in the word count.)
- The format of your presentation. (Traditional paper, lecture-recital, panel, paired papers, or video essay/audio paper)

- Technology or equipment requirements other than a projector and sound system.
- Each participant's name and institutional affiliation (if applicable)
- Contact information for the presenter or group coordinator

Presentations will be chosen based on their scholarly / research quality and originality. Confirmation of acceptance will be communicated by February 24, 2023 at the latest.

(Tip: It is thereafter possible for participants to apply individually for external funding for conference participation.)

Conference fee, registration and participation

The preliminary conference fee is 1250 kr. The membership fee to SSM is an additional 250 SEK. The conference fee includes coffee breaks, lunch and the conference dinner on June 14th, as well as coffee on June 13th and 15th. The conference fee applies regardless of your level of attendance.

Furthermore: For doctoral students not employed by their institutions, students (e.g., Master, Magister, undergraduate) and retirees the preliminary reduced conference fee is 750 SEK in addition to the membership fee.

The conference fee will be confirmed in the new year, due to the current unstable inflation situation.

The deadline for registration is **May 1st, 2023**. All fees must be paid to *bankgiro 5227-4784* by this date.

Facilities and equipment

All lecture halls will be equipped with projectors, sound systems and wireless internet. More information will be available on the SSM website.

Travel and accommodations
